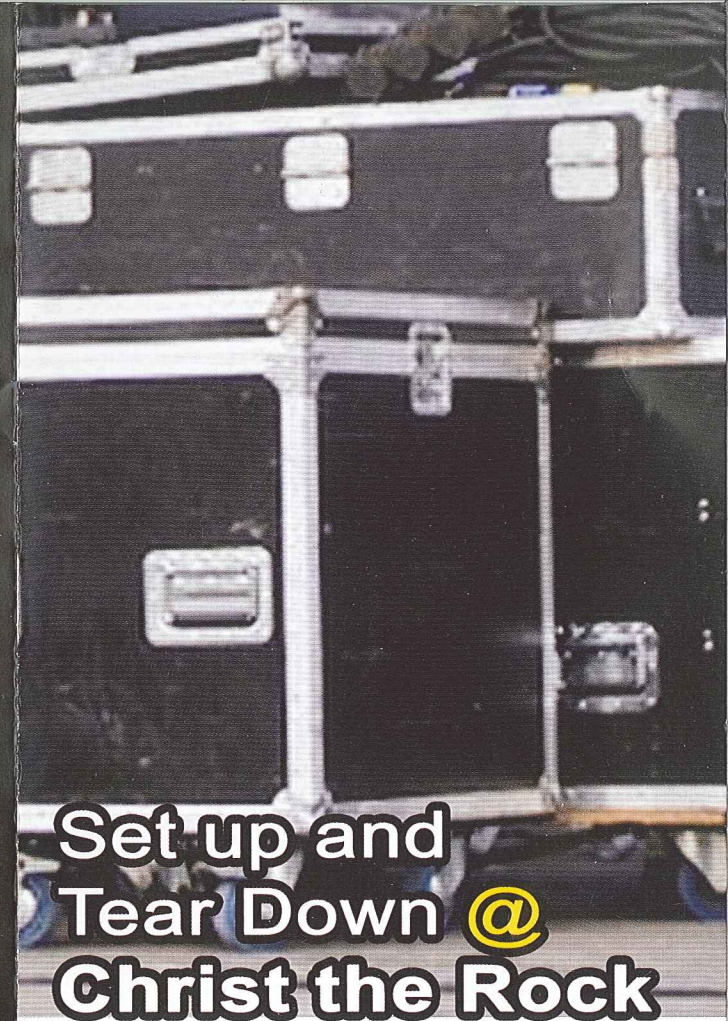


Then the Kohathites set out, carrying the holy things. Before they they arrived at the next camp, the Tabernacle would already be set up at its new location.

## Set up Crew FAQ's

### Who gets involved with the Set up Crew?

Anyone with a desire to see Christ the Rock worship services be the best they can be. The Set up Crew is made up of people who consider Christ the Rock their church home. Our backgrounds range from active professionals to those with no prior experience, but we strongly believe in "making" crew people out of anyone with a desire to learn. We use an on-the-job training approach to work with you, regardless of your skill level.

### What does the Set up Crew do?

Before the service, the Set up Crew unloads the trailer and begins set up. We set up the sound, lighting, video, and stage equipment used to create the look and feel of the worship services. We also setup unique environments for our Kidz Jam, Tiny Tots and the Infant Care Room. At the end of the service the Tear Down Crew puts everything back together and re-loads the trailer.

### What is expected?

- Serve in a crew position, Set Up or Tear Down for an entire month on a 2 month rotation.
- Participation in a weekly Connect Group.
- Continued commitment to improving your skills.
- Attend Rock Climbing 101

### Why should I join?

The primary reason you should join this team is to experience the joy and significance of serving God and the church. You will enter into a genuine community of fellowship with other Christians who support each other, work hard together, and have a lot of fun.
